C. PARTIES TO A COMPLAINT

The Complainant may be:

- § a person, group, or organization named or alluded to in a published article who is aggrieved;
- § a member of a student publication (e.g. student, editor, faculty adviser, etc.) who has an unresolved personnel issue; or

3. Grievances that fail to meet these standards shall be dismissed without a hearing by the Publications Board. Note that in the event that a grievance is accepted for a hearing, the subject of the grievance shall be sent a copy of the grievance and shall have at least 10 business days from the time of initial notification to the date of an actual hear
