Policy Statement

Financial Aid Tuition Deferrals

Background

Payment may be deferred, however, if the student is expected to receive some form of financial aid. For example, a deferral may be considered when all the necessary financial aid papers are on file but the student is experiencing some delay in the matriculation process.

This statement sets forth guidelines for determining the appropriate type(s) of financial aid against which a tuition deferral may be offered.

Policy

For eligible students, consider the various financial aid programs in accordance with the following order and criteria. The parents' federal tax returns (or student's, if claiming independent status) are needed for each.

The first preference should be Federal Pell Grants.

In the State's State Higher Education Assistance Corporation, use federal grants to pay for tuition and fees. Use the college's financial aid office to determine eligibility for each program.

Children and a possible receipt of the application of financial aid.
