• **Community-based instruction** and **cooperation**, and **scheduling** shall not be construed as the sole means for compliance in a situation of a **shortage of instructors**.

2. *Initial scheduling*

3. The University should make available to all students, in the appropriate course or courses,

- a. Information concerning the temporary nature of employment, if possible, to provide a three-day schedule.**

3.3. Employment

3.3.1. Temporary employment should be made available to students during their permanent registration, and during vacation periods, including the summer period and holidays.

3.3.2. The university may designate one or more locations for temporary employment.

3.3.3. The following shall be considered in providing for the continual availability:

- 1. The ability to meet the local economic needs which reflect any long-term or permanent regular employment which is likely to occur, that is, sufficient numbers of permanent employees to support minimum employment.**
- 2. A clearly defined role of the department in offering or providing temporary employment, in fulfilling its responsibilities in the placement service, and those with an unstated function on the campus in the same service (i.e., day or evening). During the vacation day situated facilities of public agencies, etc., to the other essential.**

In this particular section, however, it is intended to include, insofar as may follow, those which provide an economic function or a service function.
