

Credentials and Processes for Transfer
from One Discipline to Another (6-4-87)

The Faculty member must have 21 or more credits, 15 of which must be graduate and up to 6 may be undergraduate. In addition, the 15 graduate credits must include at least 6 in the new discipline.
